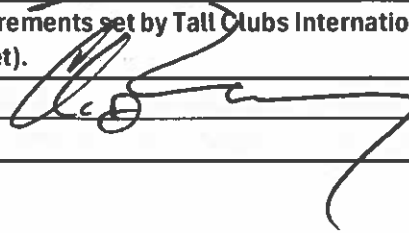

Truitt and his family moved to Texas from Washington during the COVID pandemic. They began attending our church as well as our Christian school.

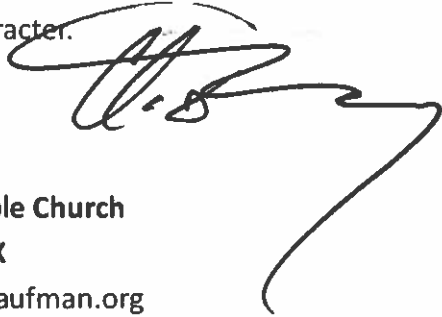
